Students Code of Conduct

- Students are expected to reach school by 7.50 am. Disciplinary action
 will be taken against students for late arrival. The School counselor may
 call the parents to take their wards back home. Latecomers will not be
 allowed to go to the classrooms.
- Students are required to behave with dignity and treat all staff and fellow students, visitors with respect and courtesy at all times.
- Habitual indiscipline, disrespectful behavior towards teachers and damage to school property may be sufficient reasons for suspension from the school and dismissal from the school bus.
- Any student found indulging in acts of indiscipline, violence, vandalism, or any kind of discrimatory practice will be suspended/ expelled from school. The decision of the Principal shall be final.
- Bullying, fights, verbal abuse or provoking a fight is strictly prohibited. Indulging in such activities will invoke strict disciplinary action/ suspension/ expulsion.
- Students are expected to maintain order and discipline at all times during school hours and should not touch other students' belongings. School adopts 'No touch policy' in the interest of students security.
- Students are not allowed to leave the class without a class pass.
- Bringing smart watches, expensive gadgets, pen knives, blades, balls, holi
 colours, fire-crackers is strictly prohibited. Students are not allowed to
 bring birthday cakes and plastic bags to school.
- Borrowing and lending of money as well as exchanging articles is prohibited. The school is not responsible for any loss occurred.
- Students are not allowed to use the school telephone without the permission of the Receptionist. They will not be called to answer phone calls during class hours.
- Canteen facility is only available during break time or after the school is over. (If there is an emergency, children can avail this facility with the concerned Class Representative's permission slip).
- 12. The School campus must not be littered with disposable tumblers, papers or polythene bags. Students are advised to keep their classroom and the school campus as clean as possible, and throw leftovers into the dustbins.

- 13. The School discourages birthday celebrations in school. Children must come to school in the regular uniform on their birthdays. Gifts / cake etc. for students as well as staff are not to be brought on any occasion.
- 14. The school does not permit any student to go directly from school to attend any kind of celebrations / parties nor will it give the telephone number or address of any student for sending invitations. It would not be the responsibility of school in case the student decides to join such celebrations after school dispersal.
- 15. The school does not permit students to bring Mobile phones, I Pads, Tablets, Speakers or any other electronic gadget to school. The school is not responsible for any loss incurred.
- 16. If any student is found using mobile phone/tablet, sending obscene messages, watching inappropriate material in the school premises, the gadget will not only be confiscated but also strict action will be taken against the student. Misuse of social media sites against staff or students can also lead to expulsion.
- The confiscated phone/gadget shall be handed over only to the parent concerned.
- 18. School is a tobacco free and no smoking zone. Any student caught smoking or in possession of cigarette, hookah, drugs etc. in school premises will be immediately rusticated.
- School discourages students from participating in any form of social media such as Facebook, Instagram etc. for their security.
